

1 5. I was never instructed by any agent of the FBI, or any
2 officer or agent of any other law enforcement agency, to search for
3 child pornography, or evidence of any other crime, on customers'
4 computers at Best Buy, at any time. I was also never instructed by
5 anyone at the FBI or at Best Buy to ask my subordinates to do so. I
6 never instructed my subordinates to search for child pornography, or
7 evidence of any other crime, on customers' computers at Best Buy, at
8 any time. I am unaware of any other supervisor at Best Buy
9 instructing anyone at Best Buy Geek Squad to search for evidence on
10 behalf of the FBI. My intent in contacting the FBI about any
11 evidence found by technicians was simply to do the right thing and
12 get the evidence out of the hands of Best Buy/ Geek Squad.

13 6. I received money from the FBI on one occasion in 2008. I
14 was extremely reluctant and irritated that the FBI gave me money, and
15 tried to give it back. I contacted our legal department, and
16 ultimately gave the money to a local charity that benefits battered
17 women. I did not understand the payment to be given as encouragement
18 to find child pornography on behalf of the FBI, and was never
19 encouraged to find child pornography on customers' computers for the
20 FBI. The money was entirely irrelevant to me. The FBI indicated to
21 me they could not take the money back because they had to spend it as
22 part of their budget.

23 I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the United
24 States of America that the foregoing is true and correct and that
25 this declaration is executed at Denver, Colorado, on January 4, 2017.
