CRIMINAL COMPLAINT

The undersigned, under penalty of perjury, complains and says that on or about the 28 day of July 20 14 in the County of Bernalillo, State of New Mexico, the above-named defendant(s) did (here state the essential facts):

On July 28, 2014 I was dispatched to 6509 Pino Rd NE, in reference to a possible Aggravated Assault call. Upon arrival I made contact with Gloria Baca-Lucero. Baca-Lucero stated that she had a man later identified as Clifton Ratliff from Comcast come to her residence to do some work. Baca-Lucero stated that when Ratliff told her there was going to be some charges for the work she wanted done, she told him it was supposed to be free work. Baca-Lucero stated that she called the customer service line with Comcast to explain the situation to them. The customer service line told her that the work was not going to be free. Baca-Lucero stated that Ratliff told her if she did not sign for the charges he would leave. Baca-Lucero stated that she refused to sign for the charges. Baca-Lucero stated that Ratliff did leave the property. Baca-Lucero stated that Ratliff returned to the property to get a tool bag in which he had left outside. Baca-Lucero stated that she took the tool bag inside her house. Baca Lucero stated that She told Ratliff to leave the property. Baca-Lucero stated that she told Ratliff he could not have his tools and that his supervisor would need to come pick them up. Baca-Lucero stated that Ratliff was standing in the driveway of her yard and refused to leave. Baca-Lucero stated that she went back inside the house and retrieved her handgun. Baca-Lucero stated that she came out of the house onto her porch with the hand gun and pointed it in the air. Baca Lucero stated that she told Ratliff "are you going to leave now"? Baca-Lucero stated that Ratliff then left the property. Baca-Lucero stated that she went back inside and called the police. Baca-Lucero stated that Ratliff was not trying to force his way into the house. Baca-Lucero stated that he was just standing outside refusing to leave.

I made contact with Clifton Ratliff. Ratliff stated that when he told Baca-Lucero that if she did not sign for the charges he would

The undersigned, under penalty of perjury, complains and says that on or about the 28 day of July, 2014 in the County of Bernalillo, State of New Mexico, the above-named defendant(s) did (here state the essential facts):

leave. Ratliff stated that Baca-Lucero refused to sign for the charges so he started putting his tools back in his vehicle. Ratliff stated that as he was putting some of his tools in the vehicle, he saw Baca-Lucero grab one of his tools bags and take it inside the house. Ratliff stated that he went and knocked on the door and asked for his tools back. Ratliff stated that the tool bag had a dollar value of \$400.00. Ratliff stated that a different woman later identified as Stephanie Melendez answered the door. Ratliff stated that Melendez told him she could not give him his tools and he needed to leave and then she closed the door. Ratliff stated that he was walking off the porch. Ratliff stated that he had just stepped off the porch when Baca-Lucero stepped out of the house and pulled out a black handgun from her right front pocket. Ratliff stated that Baca-Lucero pointed the black handgun which looked like a 9mm handgun at Ratliff's torso. Ratliff stated that Baca-Lucero stated "you need to get off my property now". Ratliff stated he put his hands up and told her "I am leaving". Ratliff stated he walked away from the property and called 911. Ratliff stated that he put his hands up because he "did not want to get shot". Ratliff did provide a written and taped statement. Ratliff did state that he is willing to prosecute.

Baca-Lucero was read her Miranda rights and placed under arrest for Aggravated Assault with a deadly weapon. Baca-Lucero was booked on Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon.
